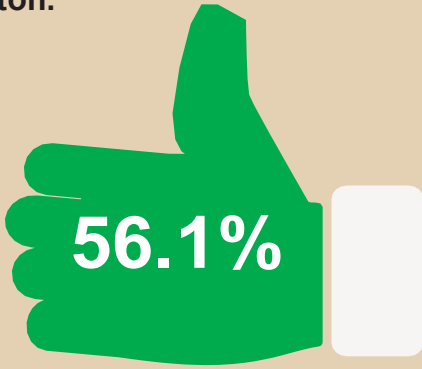


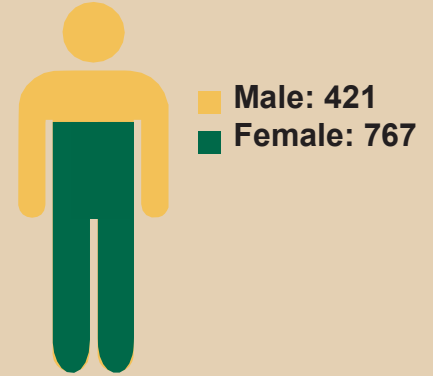
Changes to gluten free prescribing survey results

The CCGs have made some changes in relation to an area called 'low priority prescribing' in line with many other NHS organisations in Lancashire and nationally. This infographic shows the results generated from a survey sent out to local residents in Chorley, South Ribble and Greater Preston.

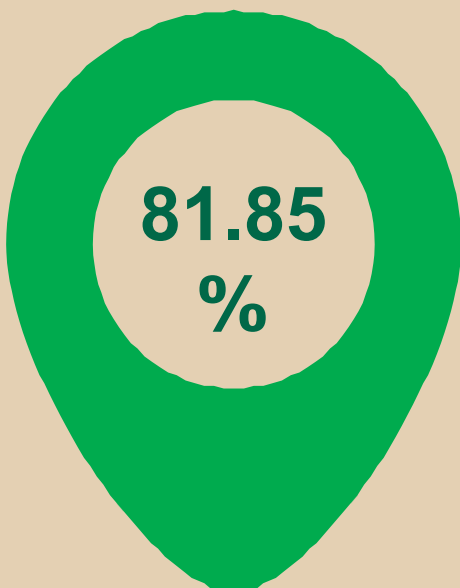
